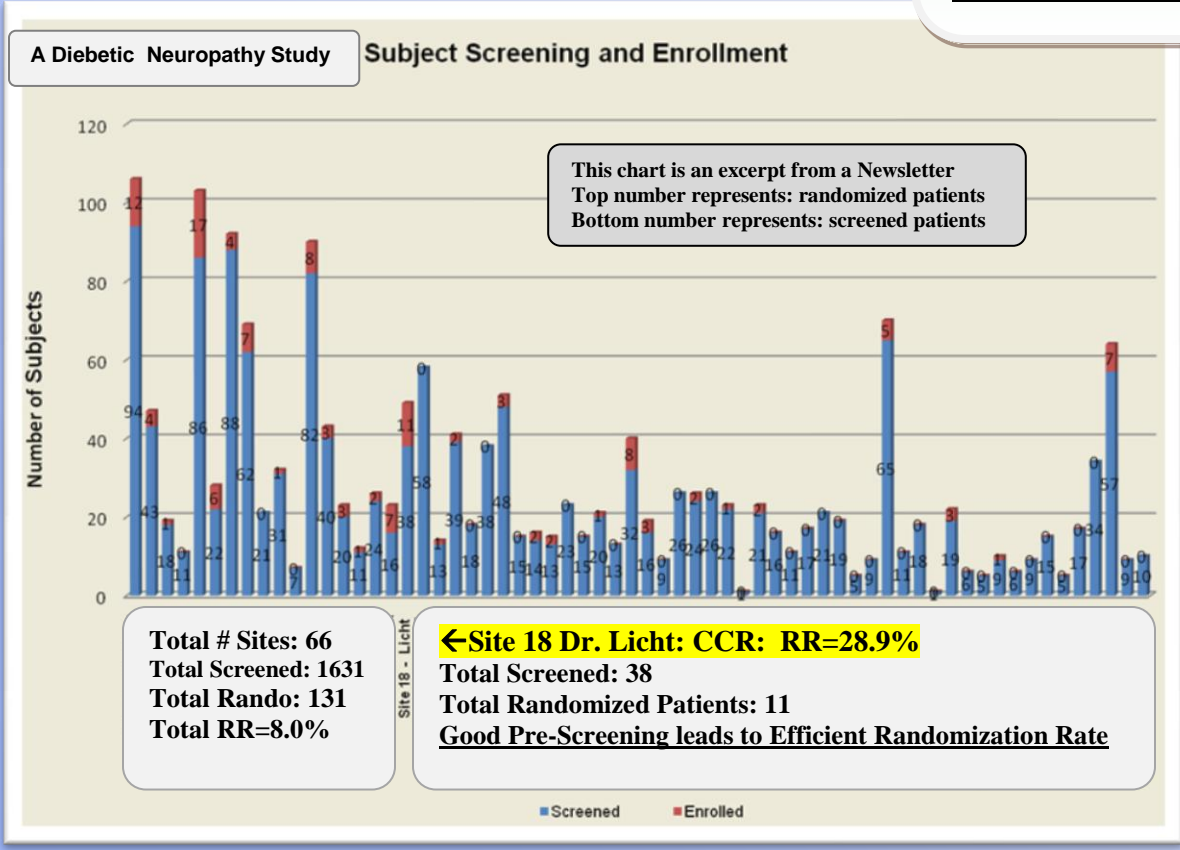
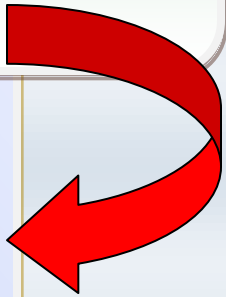
# Superior Recruitment Strategies—How We Minimize SF

At Coordinated Clinical Research, we only accept the studies that we feel confident enrollment goals will be met or exceeded. Most of our patients come from the following sources:

- ✓ Research patient database
- ✓ Private practice patient database (PI and Sub-I)
- ✓ Physician referrals
- ✓ Radio/TV advertisements
- ✓ Newspaper/local free paper advertisements
- ✓ Direct mail

We minimize screen failures by interviewing potential subjects as thoroughly as possible, utilizing an IRB approved telephone questionnaire specific to the study.

**A recent diabetic neuropathy study had an overall randomization rate (RR) of 8.0% with 1631 screened and 131 randomized. CCR was able to achieve one of the highest randomization rates with fewer screening failure.**
